### Who We Are

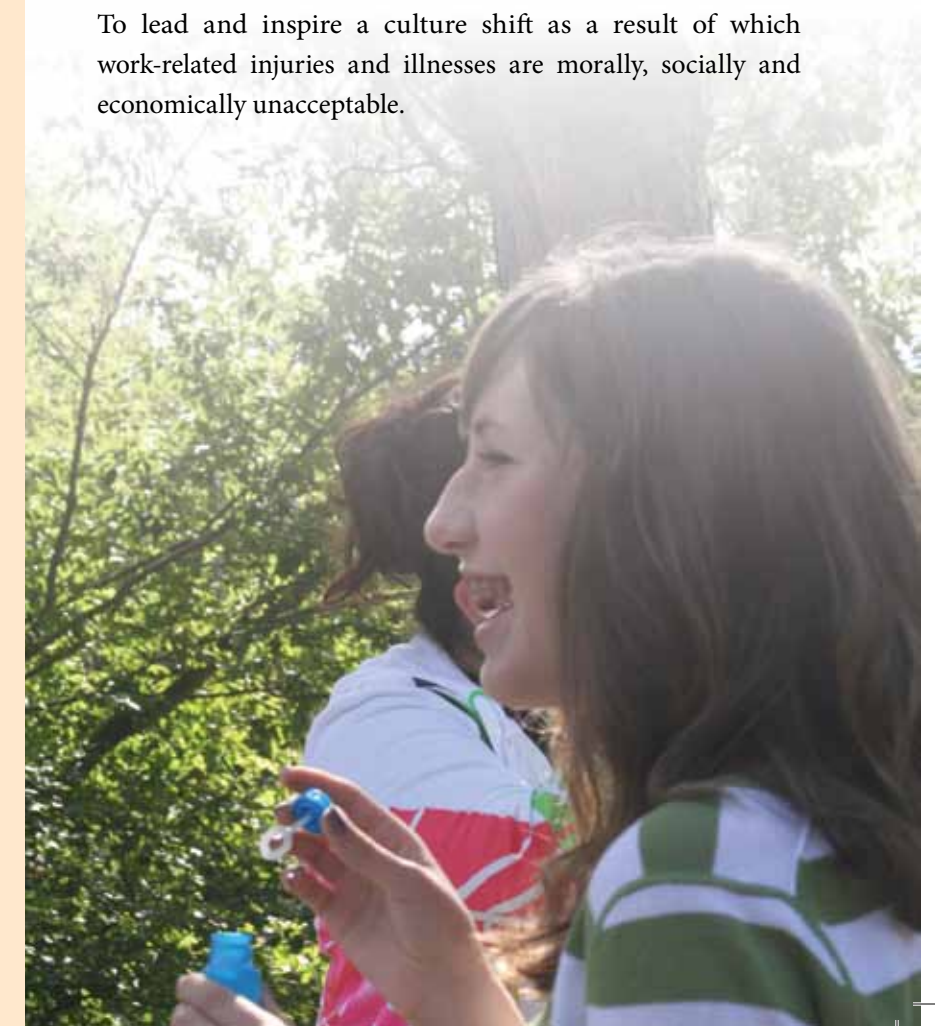
